BLACK BEACH and COTTONWOOD BEACH CAMPGROUNDS REOPENED

ALCOVA RESERVOIR — The State Bridge Engineer has reevaluated the County's request to allow one-way traffic over the Alcova bridge. This afternoon, July 1st, the north- and southbound lanes of County 407 (Kortes Rd) are narrowed to one lane as motorists approach the bridge. Temporary STOP signs are placed on both ends thereof to alternate traffic over its downstream side. Concurrent therewith, both Black Beach and Cottonwood Beach Campgrounds have reopened to campers and recreationists. Synchronized traffic lights have been ordered and will replace the STOP signs as soon as practicable.

Natrona County Road-n-Bridge Dept will post the bridge at twelve, twenty-two and twenty-five tons (12T, 22T & 25T) for the Type 3, Type 3S2 and Type 3-3 Wyoming legal trucks, respectively, until the bridge is replaced.
